III Attestation

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, do hereby certify that:

1. Finland has been free from notifiable avian influenza⁽²⁾ in accordance with the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code for 90 days before the export of egg products;
2. the area from which the fresh shell eggs used for the production of egg products originate (the area of 50 km radius from the premises of origin) have been free from Newcastle disease in accordance with the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code for 90 days prior to the export of the egg products;
3. the premises of origin of the poultry, from which the fresh shell eggs used for the production of the egg products originate, have been free from Fowl Cholera and other serious/important poultry infectious diseases designated by the competent authority of Finland for at least 90 days prior to the export of the egg products;
4. hygienic measures have been taken in the establishments handling the fresh shell eggs and egg products;
5. the fresh shell eggs used for the production of egg products are free from feculences, originate from an area and premises fulfilling the conditions of points 2 and 3 and their transport from the premises of origin to the establishments where egg products are produced is done in a safe manner from an animal health point of view; and
6. containers and packaging materials used for the egg products are clean and hygienic.

The egg products shall be transported and stored in such a manner that prevents contamination with pathogens of any animal infectious disease prior to export to Japan.

⁽¹⁾ Products made of eggs of chicken, quail, turkey, ostrich, guinea fowl, pheasant and birds classified into Anseriformes order (such as duck and goose) can be exported using this certificate

⁽²⁾ Notifiable Avian Influenza means infection of poultry caused by either: i) any influenza A virus of H5 or H7 subtype; or
ii) any influenza A virus other than H5 and H7 subtypes defined as highly pathogenic according to the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code
