KEEP PLANT PESTS AND DISEASES OUT OF THE EUROPEAN UNION



You are NOT allowed to bring plants, fruit, vegetables, flowers or seeds into the European

Union without a phytosanitary certificate.

Bananas, coconuts, dates, pineapples and durians can be brought into the EU without a certificate. Plant material from Switzerland can be brought into the EU without a certificate too. Plant material needs a certificate if it comes from the following EU territories: Ceuta, Melilla, the Canary Islands, Guadeloupe, French Guiana, Martinique, La Réunion, Saint-Barthélemy, and Saint-Martin.
