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III Attestation

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, do hereby certify that:

- 1. Finland has been free from notifiable avian influenza (2) in accordance with the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code for 90 days before the export of fresh shell eggs;
- 2. the area from which the fresh shell eggs originate (the area of 50 km radius from the premises of origin) has been free from Newcastle disease in accordance with the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code for 90 days prior to the export of the eggs;
- 3. the premises of origin of the poultry, from which the fresh shell eggs originate, have been free from Fowl Cholera and other serious/important poultry infectious diseases designated by the competent authority of Finland for at least 90 days prior to the export of the eggs;
- 4. hygienic measures have been taken in the establishments handling the fresh shell eggs;
- 5. the fresh shell eggs are free from feculences, originate from an area and premises fulfilling the conditions of points 2 and 3 and their transport from the premises of origin to the establishments is done in a safe manner from an animal health point of view; and
- 6. containers and packaging materials used for the fresh shell eggs are clean and hygienic.

The fresh shell eggs shall be transported and stored in such a manner that prevents contamination with pathogens of any animal infectious disease prior to export to Japan.

⁽²⁾ Notifiable Avian Influenza means infection of poultry caused by either: i) any influenza A virus of H5 or H7 subtype; or

ii) any influenza A virus other than H5 and H7 subtypes defined as highly pathogenic according to the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code
